

Slovenská archeológia is scientific journal published by Archaeological institute of Slovak academy of sciences. Since year 1953, there were 116 issues published, containing 818 scientific papers and hundreds of reports about scientific happenings and book reviews.

Journal is designed for Slovak and foreign specialists in the field of archaeology and interested people from other scientific disciplines.

Slovenská archeológia publishes scientific studies about most important archaeological finds and major problems concerning prehistory, protohistory and middle ages in Slovakia and central Europe. Great emphasis is placed on presentation of interdisciplinary cooperation.

Around one fifth of the content are papers not only concerning related scientific disciplines, but also natural sciences (anthropology, paleobotany, geophysics, mineralogy, petrography, pedology, metallography etc.).

Members of the editorial board are leading Slovak and foreign scholars – from Czech Republic, Austria, Germany and Poland. All papers are considered by two reviewers, experts in the related topic. Reviews are standardized, reviewers are completing the forms, in which is formal and scientific level of the submitted papers considered. Foreign authors include around one quarter of published papers. During the existence of journal, foreign authors come from 15 countries, in the last 10 years mostly from Germany, Austria, Czech Republic, Hungary, Poland and Romania.

Journal is at this time recorded in European Reference Index for the Humanities (ERIH) database and online accessible abstracts are recorded in Central European journal of Social Sciences and Humanities (CEJSH) database. Full text of volumes from years 1953 – 2004 is also online accessible.
